CRAE's *You've got the Right* programme is aimed at empowering children and young people to take action to uphold their rights. We are calling on lawyers across England who are committed to acting for children and young people, to help us ensure that children's rights are heard, respected and protected.

In 2010, CRAE is delivering *You've got the Right* through a combination of our national telephone and email [advice service](#) for children and young people on human rights and equality law, and our [children's rights training programme](#), which is delivered to vulnerable children across England and hosted by local youth groups, children's homes and other services working with children.

We want to improve our links across England with lawyers who are committed to acting for children and young people, so that we can more effectively signpost and refer children and young people accessing our advice service, as well as informing children and young people attending our training sessions about the legal services in their area.

We are therefore developing a **national network of lawyers** who are committed to acting for children and young people in a variety of contexts. Relevant specialisms include (but are not limited to): **Children law, Public law and human rights, Immigration law, Education law and Criminal law.** Lawyers who join the network will also have the opportunity to **co-deliver a children's rights training session** in their local area. In the longer term CRAE hopes to make the legal network a publicly available resource.
